Under the leadership and supervision of the Assistant Superintendent of Schools and the Supervisor of School Psychology, the School Psychologist will work as a member of the multi-disciplinary team of the Louis Riel School Division's Clinical Services. The School Psychologist will work closely with school and program-based teams in providing services to support student learning, The School Psychologist will provide services including assessments, programming and therapeutic interventions and consultative services within a three tier model of service delivery in the Louis Riel School Division.

REQUIRED AND PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- must have a minimum of a Masters degree in a school psychology program or a clinical psychology program
- must be eligible for or in possession of a Manitoba School Clinician (School Psychologist) Certificate
- bilingual (French/English) would be an asset
- excellent technology skills in order to complete all on-line recording and reporting requirements
- effective critical incident response skills
- valid drivers' licence and access to a reliable vehicle required
